

Broadford Bridge Well Site

Overview

Kimmeridge Oil and Gas Limited, which is owned by UK Oil and Gas Limited, has an environmental permit to drill, and test, a well at Broadford Bridge near Billingshurst.

A permit was issued on 19 June 2014 to allow the well to be drilled. This permit was then varied in July 2017 to allow the well to be tested. The permit contains conditions which will help ensure that communities and the environment are protected.

The Environment Agency, as the regulatory authority for environmental permits, carry out a number of activities to assess the operator's compliance with the conditions of the environmental permit.
